

Policy on Conflicting or Outdated Policies

Although The John Marshall Law School makes every effort to avoid promulgating policies that conflict with other law-school policies and reviews policies regularly to ensure they are up-to-date, if an individual discovers a policy conflict or an outdated policy, the Law School encourages him or her to report the issue to either the General Counsel and Assistant Dean for Human Resources or the Vice Dean for Academic Affairs, especially before relying on a policy that appears to conflict with another or that appears outdated.
