Awarding Diplomas

The University of Illinois at Chicago will award diplomas at the conclusion of the fall and spring semesters and the summer term, after confirming with the Law School Registrar's Office that graduation and other requirements have been met. Absent extraordinary circumstances, as determined by the Dean, to receive a diploma, a student must have completed all graduation requirements by the date the Registrar establishes for faculty to submit grades for graduating students. In addition, absent extraordinary circumstances, the student must not have any pending Honor Code, Student Code of Professional Conduct, or disciplinary matters; admission application amendments; or criminal charges.
